Provide issuance, shipping, and expedite fees with a certified bank check in US dollars with US bank name on front of check, international money order in US dollars, international postal money order in US dollars, completed credit card form below, or PayPal (email/call for instructions) to the above address;

How to register as a World Citizen

You will have to print this form to register, since it requires a signature. To have a printed form mailed to you, write to the World Service Authority in Washington, D.C. (See address below)

All registered world citizens will receive the World Citizen Card, laminated and in 7 languages: English, French, Spanish, Arabic, Russian, Chinese and Esperanto. The possession of this card is evidence of a global political status allied with each and every other declared and registered World Citizen.

CREDO OF A WORLD CITIZEN

A World Citizen is a human being who lives intellectually, morally and physically in the present. A World Citizen accepts the dynamic fact that the planetary human community is interdependent and whole, that humankind is essentially one. A World Citizen is a peaceful and peacemaking individual, both in daily life and contacts with others. As a global person, a World Citizen relates directly to humankind and to all fellow humans spontaneously, generously and openly. Mutual trust is basic to his/her lifestyle. Politically, a World Citizen accepts a sanctioning institution of representative government, expressing the general and individual sovereign will in order to establish and maintain a system of just and equitable world law with appropriate legislative, judiciary and enforcement bodies. A World Citizen brings about better understanding and protection of different cultures, ethnic groups and language communities by promoting the use of a neutral international language, such as Esperanto. A World Citizen makes this world a better place to live in harmoniously by studying and respecting the viewpoints of fellow citizens from anywhere in the world.

AFFIRMATION

I, the undersigned, do hereby, willingly and consciously, declare myself to be a Citizen of the World. As a World Citizen, I affirm my planetary civic commitment to WORLD GOVERNMENT, founded on three universal principles of One Absolute Value, One World, and One Humanity which constitute the basis of World Law. As a World Citizen, I acknowledge the WORLD GOVERNMENT as having the right and duty to represent me in all that concerns the General Good of humankind and the Good of All. As a Citizen of World Government, I affirm my awareness of my inherent responsibilities and rights as a legitimate member of the total world community of all men, women, and children, and will endeavor to fulfill and practice these whenever and wherever the opportunity presents itself. As a Citizen of World Government, I recognize and reaffirm citizenship loyalties and responsibilities within the communal state, and/or national groupings consistent with the principles of unity above which constitute now my planetary civic commitment.

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Exit Visa & Residence Permit Applications

EXPLANATION

On March 1, 1990, the World Service Authority (WSA) began issuing on demand the **International Exit Visa** (IEV), and the **International Residence Permit** (IRP). In the case of the IRP, only registered World Citizens may apply.

The International Exit Visa, as the WSA passport itself, is mandated by Article 13(2), Universal Declaration of Human Rights:

“Everyone has the right to leave any country, including his own, and to return to his country.”

The International Residence Permit is mandated by Article 13(1), Universal Declaration of Human Rights:

“Everyone has the right to freedom of movement and residence within the borders of each state.”

The IEV and the IRP will be affixed only on the World Service Authority passport. Applicants for new passports may include the application for the IEV, and/or the IRP. Applicants for the IEV and/or the IRP who already have the WSA passport must return their WSA passports to a WSA office for their issuance. Postage must be included for the return. (See application form below.)

The International Exit Visa will be placed on the first empty visa page (normally page 8) and the International Residence Permit will be placed on the second empty visa page (normally page 9). Both are in seven languages: Arabic, Chinese, English, Esperanto, French, Russian, and Spanish.

The issuing fee for the IEV is US\$20. The issuing fee for the IRP is US\$20 (+US\$30 -- World Citizen Registration).

All Heads of State have been informed by letter of the issuance of both the IEV and the IRP. All bearers of the IEV and IRP receive a copy of this letter for handy reference.

IMPORTANT

The World Service Authority as the issuing agency of the International Exit Visa and the International Residence Permit assumes no responsibility for the position of any state or government with regard to recognition of the IEV's or the IRP's validity. The bearer of the WSA passport accepts full responsibility for any and all consequences resulting from its attempted use.

However, should any state deny the validity either of the IEV or the IRP and thus deny any individual from leaving any state or choosing a residence, such denial(s) with all details should be immediately reported to the World Judicial Commission, c/o WSA, 5 Thomas Circle, NW, Washington, D.C. 20005.
